GUALA CLOSURES S.P.A. ANNOUNCES THE LAUNCH OF ITS OFFERING OF SENIOR SECURED NOTES DUE 2028 TO REFINANCE CERTAIN OF ITS EXISTING DEBT

Alessandria, Italy, June 21, 2021 — Guala Closures S.p.A. (the "Company") announces today the launch of an offering of Senior Secured Notes due 2028 (the "Notes") in an aggregate principal amount of €475 million (the "Offering"). The Offering was approved by the Company's board of directors.

Following the issuance, the Notes are expected to be listed on one or more multilateral trading facilities in the European Union.

In connection with the Offering, the Company also announces that it expects to enter into a new €80 million multi-currency revolving credit facility agreement (the "New RCF") to replace the existing revolving credit facility (the "Existing Revolving Credit Facility"), which will be available to support, among others, the working capital requirements of the group (together with the Offering, the "Refinancing").

The proceeds from the Offering, if completed, are expected to be used, along with certain cash resources available to the Company and potential drawings under the New RCF, to redeem the Company's €455 million in aggregate principal amount of Senior Secured Notes due 2024 (the "Existing Notes") at a price equal to 100% of the aggregate principal amount thereof, to repay amounts outstanding under the Company's Existing Revolving Credit Facility, to pay accrued interest on the Existing Notes and the Existing Revolving Credit Facility, and to pay fees and expenses associated with the Refinancing. This follows the occurrence of the "change of control" pursuant to the indenture governing the Existing Notes in connection with the mandatory tender offer launched by Special Packaging Solutions Investments S.à r.l.

The Company also announces that it estimates that its net revenue will be in the range of €235 million to €245 million for the five months ended May 31, 2021 as compared to approximately €229 million for the five months ended May 31, 2020. In addition, the Company estimates that its Adjusted EBITDA for the five months ended May 31, 2021 will be higher than its Adjusted EBITDA for the corresponding period of 2020. This information is based on preliminary management accounts including results that are not for an entire period and is subject to change. These preliminary results should not be viewed as a substitute for full interim financial statements.
