

GUALA CLOSURES GROUP DONATES PROTECTIVE FACE SHIELDS MADE WITH 3D PRINTERS FOR THE DOCTORS AND NURSES OF ALESSANDRIA HOSPITAL

A donation is also on the way to the Hospital in Termoli, where the Group has a production plant

Spinetta Marengo, 31 March 2020 – Guala Closures Group, world leader in the production of closures for food and beverages, donates 300 protective face shields for the doctors and nurses of the National Hospital *Ss Antonio e Biagio e Cesare Arrigo* in Alessandria. The face shields were made using 3D printers thanks to the commitment of teams of the Group's engineers who work in the research, development and innovation centres in Spinetta Marengo (AL) and in Luxembourg. The 3D printer is able to produce 50 face shields per day, half of which are assembled at Guala Closures' facility in Alessandria and the other in Luxembourg.

The first protective face shields have been delivered to the hospital in Alessandria from today, 31 March 2020, and will be donated continuously for as long as necessary. The protective face shields will also be given to the Local Health Company (ASL) which will manage the distribution of materials to the Special Continuity Care Units (USCA), whose doctors reach the patients in isolation at home, as well as the health workers who carry out the diagnostic swabs testing for the detection of COVID-19.

In addition to the hospital in Alessandria, a donation is also planned for the Hospital in Termoli, where the Group has another production plant

The material used to make the face shields is polycarbonate provided by the Alessandria-based company Fast Covering Systems, which in less than 48 hours sent 500 sheets to Guala Closures Group.

With regard to the model of the protective face shields, one called Prusa3d was selected from several existing types, as it had already obtained two health compliance certificates from the Ministry of Health in the Czech Republic.

Each of us can use our experience and professional skills to contribute to supporting the health service, which is under tremendous pressure.
